



Exploring British Art Show 9 (BAS9) in the classroom: Teacher led session.

Suitable for all creative arts teachers from Primary, Secondary, SEND, alternative provision, FE and HE settings. Also open to arts and cultural organisations.

This free online session will introduce 3 British Art Show 9 Lead Teachers from across the West Midlands who are exploring BAS9 and contemporary art in their classrooms. Teachers sharing their BAS9 inspired projects are:

- Ms Thea Brown is Head of Art at The Phoenix Collegiate in Sandwell, she will be discussing how she has adapted a range of approaches in teaching contemporary art inspired by the BAS9 artists in an accessible way to a range of key stages and matching tasks to assessment objectives.
- Fay Patrick is Art and Design Coordinator at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Primary School in Birmingham, she will be sharing work from a project that started last year linked to Tai Shani's installation work. Students have been exploring how imagination, language and communication skills can be enhanced through storytelling and contemporary art practices.
- Mrs Lisa Stevens is Head of Art at Nunnery Wood High School in Worcester, which has a high volume of students who select GCSE Art and has gained Artsmark Platinum award through offering a relevant and current art curriculum focused on contemporary artists and designers. Lisa will be sharing how she has used BAS9 artists as a starting point for her GCSE students who are exploring a range of contemporary art styles and techniques.
